



Silk Ribbon Embroidery Needlebook - Supply List

1. A piece of wool approximately 6" x 9". Or, you can sew two 5" squares together to make your needlebook.
2. A piece of cotton approximately 6" x 9" for the inside. I suggest you pick that fabric out first so you can coordinate your colors.
3. Needles: You will need Crewel needles size 18 or 24. These needles have an elongated eye and you need the eye long enough to insert at least a 1/4" piece of ribbon. If you don't have Crewel needles, not to worry. I will have plenty. You will also need regular hand sewing needles. Whatever is your favorite.
4. If you have silk ribbon, bring it. I will be bringing a lot in lots of colors so don't worry if you don't have it.
5. Some 100 wt. silk thread...neutral color or colors to match your fabric. If you don't have it, you can also use regular sewing thread. I will have some of that, too.
6. An embroidery hoop. A 4" hoop is big enough to incorporate the whole design without moving it around. It doesn't really matter what kind. Most people have their favorites. If it's too big, it's hard to get your hands around it.
7. Small, sharp scissors.
