## <u>Cinnamon Spice Quilt Pattern - Class Summary</u>

Join us in this class, where we will construct the Cinnamon Spice Quilt pattern by Sugar Stitches Quilt Co (quilt top only). Do you need extra help perfecting your flying geese technique too? This class will cover the 4-at-atime method for constructing flying geese. The class will also cover fabric preparation, cutting your fabric, working with directional fabrics, piecing, and trimming flying geese.

At the conclusion of the class, students can expect:

- To learn the 4 at-a-time method for making flying geese
- To layout and assemble flying geese and other quilt blocks for the Cinnamon Spice Quilt Pattern layout NOTE: You will not complete the entire project in this class; however, all of the individual elements will be created for you to complete your project on your own

#### Pattern:

- Cinnamon Spice Quilt Pattern by Sugar Stitches Quilt Co. PDF and paper versions available at www.SugarStitchesQuiltCo.com
- NOTE: Fabrics should be cut before class to maximize learning time during class.

#### Notions:

- Sewing machine with ¼" presser foot
- Rotary mat and rotary cutter (a rotating cutting mat is helpful but not required)
- Basic sewing supplies (thread for piecing, pins and/or wonder clips, seam ripper, fabric marking pens)
- Ruler that measures at least 6" x 24" and a shorter rectangular ruler (i.e., 3 ½" x 12" or similar)
- Optional Specialty rulers for trimming flying geese

### Fabric:

- All fabric requirements are listed on the pattern and included in this supply sheet. You can choose any
  project size for the class. The layout of the pattern is the same for all sizes.
- \*Skill Level: Beginner (Ages 15+)
- \*Must have working knowledge of operating a sewing machine and basic piecing skills.
- \*Come to class with your machine cleaned and ready to use. Fill bobbins in your choice of thread for piecing.
- \*Please place your phone on silent or off so that calls do not disturb the class or teacher
- \*No visitors or students are allowed in class
- \*All beverages should have a lid. No food is allowed in the classroom.
